

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

KEMICHAL SRL (references below) as Data Controller, in the person of the Legal Representative in office, pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), informs that the personal data provided are treated in a lawful, correct and transparent way.

1. Purpose and legal basis of the processing

The data provided are processed for: the execution of a contract/order for the supply or purchase of goods or services with the Data Controller, the fulfillment of the consequent fiscal and legal obligations, the management of requests for information/quotes, the selection of personnel, the sending (always revocable) of commercial communications via e-mail, relating to products and/or services similar to those already acquired/provided by the Data Controller, as well as the exercise of the Data Controller's rights of defense. Therefore, the legal basis of the processing is the contract/order and/or pre-contractual measures (Article 6.1.b GDPR).

2. Object of the treatment

For the aforementioned purposes, personal identification and identification data are processed (e.g. name/surname, telephone, address, e-mail) collected during the pre-sale/offer, selection of personnel and the formalization of a contract/order for the supply or the purchase of products or services.

3. Processing methods

Personal data will be processed by previously authorized and trained personnel, in paper and electronic format, also through automated methods designed to store, manage and transmit them and in any case always using suitable tools, as far as possible at the state of the art, to guarantee their security and confidentiality, also through procedures aimed at avoiding the risk of loss, unauthorized access, illicit use and dissemination.

4. Provision of data

The provision of personal data to achieve the aforementioned purpose, when required, is to be considered mandatory; failure to provide them will not allow us to complete the establishment of the relationship, the processing of any requests for information and, in relation to our suppliers, to receive goods and services from them.

5. Communication and data transfer

In pursuing the purposes illustrated, the data may be disclosed to various subjects, including but not limited to:

- subjects and entities to which access to such data is recognized by virtue of regulatory provisions;
- physical, legal, public or private subjects, to whom the communication is necessary or functional to our business;
- banks, insurance companies, lawyers, software and platforms for the management of services.

In no case will the personal data provided be disseminated without authorization and the transfer of the same to a third country or to an international organization outside the EEA is also not envisaged.

6. Data retention

Personal data collected for contractual purposes will be processed until the end of the relationship and will be kept for no more than 10 years to fulfill the obligations established by current tax and fiscal legislation. The data collected as part of pre-contractual measures, requests for information and personnel selection, will be processed until the end of the activity and subsequently stored for no more than 12 months for our internal organizational purposes.

7. Rights of interested parties

The Data Controller guarantees the rights provided for in Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR, including: requesting and obtaining access to data, rectification, cancellation or limitation of processing of the same, as well as the right to object, in whole or in part, for legitimate reasons, to the processing of their personal data, to request its portability, to revoke the consent(s) provided and to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

These rights can be exercised by writing to the Data Controller by post, including electronic mail, at the addresses at the bottom of this document. It is understood that, where the access request is submitted by electronic means, the answer will always be provided in electronic format.
